



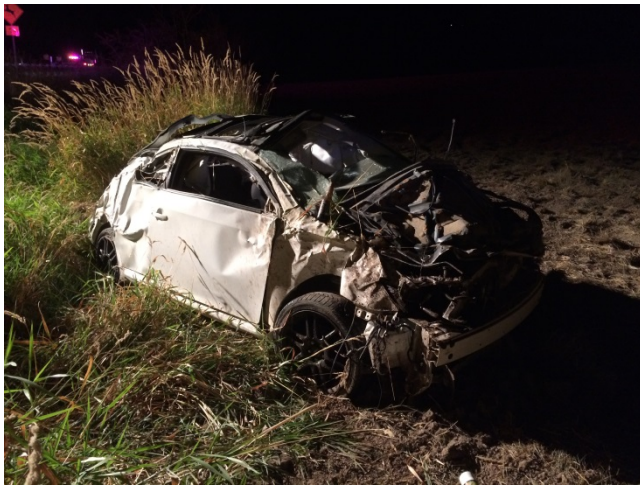

Man Dies in Single-Vehicle Crash on Highway 26

August 29, 2016 - This morning, deputies responded a roll-over crash on Highway 26 near Maller Road. The single occupant of the car died at the scene. There were no other vehicles involved in the crash.



On Monday, August 29, 2016, at about 2:24 a.m., deputies responded to a roll-over crash on Highway 26 near NW Maller Rd. Medical personnel on scene determined that the driver was deceased.

After investigating the crash, deputies determined that James D Worrell, 27, of Springfield, Missouri, was traveling west on Highway 26 at a high rate of speed. For an unknown reason, Mr. Worrell lost control of the white Scion and rolled the vehicle. The car came

to rest approximately 500 feet from the point it left the roadway, Mr. Worrell was ejected from the car during the crash.

Mr. Worrell's next of kin was notified of his death, there is no indication that any other vehicles were involved in the crash.
