Driver Arrested for DUI after Rollover Crash

September 3, 2016 – Deputies responded to a roll-over crash on NW Thompson Rd. and arrested the driver for DUI. There were no injuries but the driver ran over a fire hydrant before flipping his SUV.

On Saturday, September 3, 2016 at about 4:42 p.m., deputies responded to a single vehicle roll-over crash at NW Thompson Road and NW Hibbard Drive in the community of Bonny Slope. Deputies determined Andriv Serezentynov, 36, of Portland, was driving east on NW Thompson Rd. when he failed to negotiate a curve. Mr. Serezentynov struck a fire hydrant, but there was no water leak. Mr. Serezentynov then flipped his SUV in the ditch, landing up-side-down.

Deputies investigating the crash determined that Mr. Serezentynov had been drinking and he was arrested. He was later booked into the Washington County Jail for Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants (DUI).

The Washington County Sheriff's Office would like to remind people to drive sober this holiday weekend. Deputies will be on extra impaired driving patrols through the Labor Day weekend.
