Driver Arrested for DUII Crash and Assault

Today, July 18, 2015 at about 1:00 p.m., Sheriff's deputies responded to a crash on SW 185th Avenue near SW Rigert Rd. Two people were transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The driver was arrested for DUII and other charges.

On Saturday, July 18, 2015, at 1:03 p.m., Sheriff's deputies were called to a single-vehicle crash on SW 185th Avenue north of SW Rigert Road in the community of Aloha. A single vehicle lost control on a curve, left the roadway and turned over. The driver, Joshua Farnsworth, 30, of Beaverton and the male adult passenger were transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.



Deputies investigating the case determined that Mr. Farnsworth had been drinking heavily prior to the crash. A deputy responded to the hospital where Mr. Farnsworth was being treated and cited him for DUII, Assault 4, Reckless Driving, and Recklessly Endangering another Person. Mr. Farnsworth is scheduled to appear in court at a later date.
