Please see the below medication shortage update and protocol change authorization.

Situation: Mitigation of current ketamine shortage by narrowing indications for use.

<u>Background</u>: Ketamine is on backorder with varying timelines for availability in the distant future. Locally, AMR has been unable to order more ketamine and supplies are running short.

Assessment: Ketamine is currently unavailable for order and there is no clinical equivalent.

Recommendation: The use of ketamine will be limited to advanced airway management <u>only</u> as described in protocol 30.040 – Endotracheal Intubation.

Until ketamine can be purchased reliably and until further notice, ketamine should not be used in Protocol 10.135 – Pain Management, Section G.3 and Pediatric Section E. Again, effective immediately, we will no longer use ketamine for pain management.
