CONDITIONS		
Upon execution of this Agreement and until this Agreement is terminated or expires by its terms, the Owner shall be responsible to comply with all the following conditions of this Agreement:		
• Certify there is no available, viable option for the placement of the container on adjacent private property;		
• The container must be placed and must remain in those areas where cars are authorized to park;		
The container will be placed adjacent to Property described above and owned or controlled by person signing agreement;		
The container will be removed within two weeks of the delivery date noted above;		
• The container will be placed on a street with a driving surface greater than 26' wide unless placed on the road shoulder;		
 The roadway adjacent to the Property and upon which the container is placed is classified as an urban local or neighborhood route; The container will not block the visibility at adjacent driveways and does not create a sight obstruction at intersections; 		
 The container will not block the visibility at adjacent driveways and does not create a sight obstruction at intersections, The container does not inhibit vehicle, bicycle, or pedestrian movement; 		
The placement and use of the container will not cause damage to the roadway or adjacent features;		
The container will be removed within 24 hours if directed by the County; and		
• If remaining between sunset and sunrise, the container must be placed in a location that is lit by street lights or is marked by reflective cones, barricades or another similar reflective surface.		
Failure to Meet Conditions		
 Failure to meet any of these or any additional conditions imposed by the County may cause the County to terminate this agreement and exercise its rights to: Immediately terminate this Agreement; Direct the removal of container Not allow property owner to enter into future Storage Container agreements
