### **Existing Specifications**

Street Classification: Arterial

Posted speed: 45 mph north of Bull Mountain Rd, 55 mph to the south

**Transit:** Potential Future Route

Bike Route: Yes, Major Street Bikeway, Connects to Tualatin Valley Scenic Bikeway to the South

Truck Route: Yes, Over-Dimensional Truck Route; 6th-highest truck volume in Washington County

### Proposed Design

Number of lanes: 5 (2 travel lanes in each direction with a raised center median) \*

Lane widths: 12 feet (travel); 14 feet (median)

Right of way width: 98 feet\*

**Sidewalks:** 8 feet – both sides within the UGB

Bike lanes: 8-foot bike facility on street, both sides

Traffic Signals: Upgrades to existing signal at Scholls Ferry Road

New signal at SW Jean Louise Road\*\*
New signal at Bull Mountain Road\*\*


Landscaping: Yes
