WIN Investigators Seized Cash, Drugs and a Gun

Investigators from the Westside Interagency Narcotics (WIN) team seized methamphetamine, a handgun and cash. This information release has been delayed for investigatory reasons.

On Monday, October 17, 2016, investigators from the WIN team served a search warrant on a residence in the Quatama Village Apartment complex in the community of Quatama. This was the result of an ongoing investigation.

Investigators, assisted by Washington County narcotic-detection K9 Taz, located and seized seven pounds of methamphetamine, a semi-automatic handgun and \$194,500 in cash. The estimated street value of methamphetamine removed from distribution is over \$50,000.

Josue Valdovinos-Moreno, 24, had previously been detained and was lodged in the Washington County Jail. He was charged with Delivery of a Controlled Substance and Possession of a Controlled Substance (Methamphetamine). He is held on \$50,000 bail.



The Oregon High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program provides assistance to the WIN team and all of its participating agencies. Washington County is a designated HIDTA county.

WIN is a multi-agency team and includes members from the Washington County Sheriff's Office, Beaverton Police Department, Hillsboro Police Department, Tigard Police Department, National Guard, Federal Bureau of Investigation and Homeland Security Investigations.
