**OBJECTIVE:** To establish procedures for Exceptions to the *Washington County Tobacco Free Campus Policy*.

## **PROCEDURE:**

The *Washington County* Tobacco and Smoke-Free County Property Policy allows the County Administrative Office to grant rare exceptions based on operational need. Exceptions are to be reviewed regularly. Please note that requirements of <u>Oregon's Smoke free Workplace Law</u> still apply.

The County Administrative Office grants the following exceptions to the Tobacco and Smoke-Free County Property Policy:

- **1.** A designated area in the courtyard of the Community Corrections Center. This exception is granted for residents only, and only at limited times under staff supervision.
- 2. A designated area outside the Law Enforcement Center (LEC), located between two large vehicle storage structures at the far southeast corner of the P-10 secured parking lot. This exception is granted only for personnel (staff and contractors) assigned to the LEC.
- 3. All undeveloped and natural outdoor park areas at Scoggins Valley Park (Henry Hagg Lake) unless fire danger warrants a temporary park-wide smoke free ban. All Scoggins Valley Park Buildings and structures, restrooms and playground areas are not exempt and must remain tobacco-free and smoke-free per the Policy.
- **4.** A designated area in all Supportive Housing and Homeless Service program facilities. This exception is granted for residents and authorized visitors.
