Metal, paper, flattened cardboard, plastic bottles, & round plastic containers 6 oz or larger, empty & dry

No plastic bags or wrap, lids, glass, garbage

No lids, lightbulbs, caps, ceramics, broken glass of any type



A Hazardous waste

Includes chemicals, propane tanks and flammable items, medications, motor oil, TVs, computers or other electronics

🗑 Garbage









All garbage, including plastic bags, to-go containers, lids & packaging

No TVs, computers, batteries, hazardous waste (flammables, paint, pesticides), syringes or medical sharps
